After 45 years of service to women and families in the West San Fernando Valley, the Valley Women's Center, a 501c3 non-profit counseling center, will close its doors September 30, 2021.

Though we have maintained our services since the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic, as an organization we have also faced unprecedented challenges to continuing our mission to provide low-cost counseling, education, support and referral services to women and their families at risk for alcohol and drug abuse, domestic violence, and other threats to family stability. Among the most difficult have been the untimely deaths of our Interim Executive Director, Bob Neches, and long-serving former Executive Director Lulu Kamatoy.

To our supporters, we thank you for dedicating your time and resources to the Valley Women's Center so that our counselors have been able to provide clients the personal, compassionate attention they needed in their progress to recover from substance abuse and achieve stability and emotional well-being.

We are proud of all that we have accomplished, especially our work to help mothers who had lost custody of their children complete the center's recovery program and regain custody of their children.
